




## Guidelines for the use of citationmachine

To quickly prepare the references list of journal publications for your abstract, we recommend following the simple steps below:

1. Go to: <http://www.citationmachine.net/european-neuropsychopharmacology/cite-a-journal>  
**Note:** This service is for free.
2. Insert the title of the publication (see red arrow below):
