Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD) is a neurodevelopmental disorder of multifactorial pathogenesis. Traditionally, ADHD was assumed to be a childhood disorder. In the meantime, a persistence of symptoms into adulthood has been shown in 60% of those affected. Besides the core symptoms of inattention, hyperactivity and impulsivity, adults with ADHD often suffer from emotional dysregulation, comorbid disorders and functional impairment in multiple domains. The aim of our symposium is to present the current standard of knowledge with respect to the diagnostics and evidence-based treatment options. Relevant differential diagnoses, comorbid illnesses in adult ADHD and treatment recommendations in complex cases will be presented.
