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The legal entity organising the congress is Stichting 39th ECNP Congress, hereafter called ECNP, a foundation incorporated under Dutch law, registered office Daltonlaan 400, 3584 BK Utrecht, the Netherlands, Chamber of Commerce registration 86103814, RSIN 863862184.

All companies involved in the 39th ECNP Congress should adhere to these ECNP Industry Guidelines, the <u>ECNP Industry Rules and Regulations</u> as well as the <u>ICM Technical Regulations for Accompanying Exhibitions</u> and the <u>ECNP privacy and data security policy</u>.

The 39th ECNP Congress will be held in the <u>ICM – International Congress Center Messe München</u> and it will have a hybrid format. This means the ECNP Congress is held at the congress venue and presentations are given in-person in Munich and almost all presentations are livestreamed. Participants can choose to attend the congress in-person in Munich or follow the congress virtually from anywhere in the world.

Health Care Professionals

In order to ensure compliance, participants are required during the registration process for the 39th ECNP Congress to indicate whether they are a Health Care Professional (HCP), a non-Health Care Professional (non-HCP), or an employee of a pharmaceutical company. The responsibility for selecting the correct Health Care Professional status lies with the participant, and the chosen status will determine access to industry activities financially supported by pharmaceutical companies. For inperson participants, the non-HCP status will be printed on their badge, and for both in-person and virtual participants, it will be included in their profile for accessing industry sessions via the app and congress platform. The non-HCP status may restrict access to specific exhibition stands, industry sessions, and the ability to view livestreams or on-demand recordings. Responsibility for enforcing these restrictions lies with the organising pharmaceutical companies based on their compliance rules.

According to the Germany Health Advertising Act (HWG), HealthCare Professionals (HCPs) within the meaning of this Act are members of the health professions or the medical industry, institutions that serve the health of humans or animals, or other persons, insofar as they lawfully trade in medicinal products, medical devices, procedures, treatments, objects or other means or use them in the exercise of their profession such as doctors, dentists, veterinarians, pharmacists, apothecaries, and other individuals legally authorised to trade in or prescribe medicinal products. This excludes individuals like medical assistants, nurses, or patients, who are considered laypersons under this specific law and are non-HCPs. The responsibility of indicating the correct HealthCare Professional status is with the participant.

1. Industry Sessions

Companies and organisations involved in clinical and pre-clinical research, diagnosis, and treatment of disorders of the brain looking for scientifically driven engagement with the participants of the 39th ECNP Congress can apply for Industry Satellite Symposia, Industry Mini Session and Industry Interactive Discussions. The Industry Product Theatre and Industry Case Study are more commercially oriented and aim at offering opportunities to showcase products.

Industry Satellite Symposia (ISS)

Scientifically oriented Industry Satellite Symposium (80 minutes with a maximum of 1 chair and 4 speakers) with a well-balanced programme (e.g. not concentrating on one specific medication) may be organised.

Industry Satellite Symposia are not organised in parallel with the official ECNP scientific programme and the programmes will be reviewed for balance and rigour by the Scientific Programme Committee (SPC). The room has a standard room set-up in theatre style.

These industry sessions are presented at the congress venue for in-person participants and are livestreamed for the virtual participants. The livestreamed sessions will be recorded and made available after the congress to registered participants for on-demand viewing for a two-months period. After the congress, the recordings are also provided to the organiser of the industry session for enduring material.

The Industry Satellite Symposium has a fixed fee of EUR 73,000 (excl. VAT).

Industry Mini Sessions (IMS)

These well-balanced scientifically oriented mini sessions (45 minutes with a maximum of 1 chair and 2 speakers) take place outside the official ECNP scientific programme and programmes will be reviewed for balance and rigour by the Scientific Programme Committee (SPC). The room has a standard room set-up in theatre style.

These industry sessions are presented at the congress venue for in-person participants and are livestreamed for the virtual participants. The livestreamed sessions will be recorded and made available after the congress to registered participants for on-demand viewing for a two-months period. After the congress, the recordings are also provided to the organiser of the industry session for enduring material.

The Industry Mini Session has a fixed fee of EUR 50,500 (excl. VAT).

Industry Interactive Discussions (IID)

These interactive sessions (30 minutes with 1 or 2 experts) offer companies the opportunity to move from commercially oriented exposure to more focused, scientifically driven engagement with participants. This format allows for close interaction with participants on a specific topic. The topic is framed by experts for 6-7 minutes, then the remainder of the time is devoted to discussion with the audience. Each Industry Interactive Discussion will be reviewed by the Scientific Programme Committee (SPC). They take place in parallel with the official ECNP scientific programme.

To facilitate discussion with the audience the capacity of the room is about 80 pax. These sessions are only for in-person participants, taking place at the congress venue and will not be livestreamed or recorded.

The Industry Interactive Discussion has a fixed fee of EUR 25,500 (excl. VAT).



Industry Product Theatres (IPT)

These high-value sessions (30 minutes with a maximum of 1 speaker) provide a podium for industry to present to participants on a broad range of issues, including new treatment approaches, medical devices, digital health apps, the uses of specific medications, clinical insights, innovative services, and product demonstrations. The programme will be reviewed by the Scientific Programme Committee (SPC).

Industry Product Theatre sessions are not interactive sessions (no Q&A is included). They are presented at the congress venue for in-person participants (for about 80 pax.) and are livestreamed for the virtual participants. The livestreamed sessions will be recorded and made available after the congress to registered participants for on-demand viewing for a two-month period. After the congress, the recordings are also provided to the organiser of the industry session as enduring material.

The Industry Product Theatre has a fixed fee of EUR 32,000 (excl. VAT).

Industry Case Study (ICS)

These interactive sessions (30 minutes with 1 or 2 experts) provide participants with the opportunity to discuss the application of medicines, devices, and/or treatment strategies in real-world clinical settings. After a 6–7-minute introduction, the session focuses on interactive discussion and problem-solving with the industry expert(s). Each Industry Case Study will be reviewed by the Scientific Programme Committee (SPC). They take place in parallel with the official ECNP scientific programme. To facilitate discussion with the audience the capacity of the room is limited to around 80 people. These sessions are only for in-person participants, taking place at the congress venue and will not be livestreamed or recorded.

The Industry Case Study has a fixed fee of EUR 32,000 (excl. VAT).

Catering

For the 39th ECNP Congress there is an official caterer appointed and it is forbidden by the congress venue to bring food and beverages from outside.

Tea, coffee and lunch is provided free of charge at the exhibition and poster area during breaks as mentioned in the programme.

For Industry Satellite Symposia and for Industry Mini Sessions, limited catering is allowed but is restricted to grab and go and non-alcoholic beverages. It is not allowed to bring food or drinks into the session rooms. It may only be served up to 20 minutes before the start of these industry sessions. The area for catering is the nearest catering area available to the assigned room. Extensions beyond the assigned time slot are not allowed under any circumstances.

The industry session organisers are responsible for ensuring that the ordered supplies follow the congress guidelines. Further details will be given in the Industry Manual, to be published before 31 May 2026.

It is not allowed to provide catering during an Industry Interactive Discussion, Industry Product Theatre or Industry Case Study.

1.2 How to apply

1.2.1 Application

Companies interested in organising industry sessions must submit their application via the <u>industry session application form</u>, by 20 January 2026 at the latest. After ECNP has received the application form, the company will be issued an invoice for 100% which must be paid according to the payment terms specified. Upon applying the company accepts the industry terms and conditions and cancellations policy as stated in the <u>ECNP Industry Rules and Regulations</u>.

The Scientific Programme Committee of the ECNP Congress takes great care to achieve equal gender balance and country balance for the speakers and chairs presenting at the congress. It is mandatory for companies to take country and gender balance into account when proposing and inviting their speakers and chairs.

During submission the following information needs to be provided:

- Title of the session
- Titles of the presentation(s), if applicable
- Speakers/experts
- Chair, if applicable
- Outline of the session
- Preferences of times slots
- Expected number of participants
- Contact and invoicing details
- Company logo (maximum size of 500KB)
- Introduction text about the company (maximum of 100 words texts are subject to minor editorial adjustment for conformity to the ECNP house style.)

The information provided will be treated confidentially, as it is understood that it might be difficult for companies to approach speakers and chairs before the time slot has been fixed.

Please note that no unusual abbreviations and trade names are permitted in the title of the industry session and the presentation titles. However, generic names may be used. The title of the industry session and the titles of the presentations as well as the content must give a balanced view of therapeutic options. The use of generic names in the presentations will contribute to this.

The company name, company logo and the introduction text are requested for publication on the <u>ECNP</u> Congress website and App.

All communication about the industry session goes via one official company representative as indicated upon application. This person will be included in all communication about the session and will also have access to the industry session upload pages for providing documents for branding.

If you have more than one request, please click the 'Add application' button on the application form. The form(s) should be submitted by the industry, not by its agency.

1.2.2 Procedure after completing the application form

Information about the assessment of the pre-programme by the Scientific Programme Committee (SPC) will be sent out 17 March 2026 at the latest. To the extent it is possible, Industry sessions organised by the same industry will not be scheduled in parallel and efforts will be made to avoid running two parallel sessions on the same topic. This however really depends on the diversity of topics

provided in the applications. In addition, preferred time slots as indicated by the industry will be taken into account as much as possible. Before 20 April 2026 the final allocation of time slots will be circulated.

Requested details and materials

The organising company will need to send in the following to ECNP:

- Final version of programme including faulty members and timing of presentations for publication on the ECNP Congress website and App.
- Approving or providing biography and picture of each faculty members.
 Faculty biographies and photos from the ECNP database will be used. If not available, ECNP will ask the company to provide the missing biographies and photos.

The deadline to send in the above is 15 May 2026.

1.3 Procedure for changes in the pre-programme

In the event that there are changes to an approved pre-programme, the changes must be sent to ECNP for approval by the Scientific Programme Committee (SPC). It is mandatory to submit a final version for publication and approve biography with photographs of the speakers to ECNP before 15 May 2026 at the latest.

1.4 Rules for faculty

As is the case with the ECNP scientific programme, faculty members can give a presentation during **one industry session only** (Industry Satellite Symposium/Industry Mini Session/Industry Interactive Discussion/Industry Product Theatre/Industry Case Study). In addition, they can only chair one (other) industry session if the schedule allows it. It is mandatory for organisers to adhere to equal gender balance and country balance in their programme.

The ruling is stricter for members of the <u>ECNP Executive Committee</u> and members of the <u>Scientific Programme Committee</u> of the <u>39th ECNP Congress</u>. Members of the Scientific Programme Committee are only allowed to either speak or chair, not both. The Executive Committee members will not speak in nor chair an industry session.

It is the responsibility of the companies to inform the tentative faculty of this rule. In the event that a faculty member is proposed by several companies when submitting the pre-programmes, the companies will be informed of this by the ECNP. ECNP will not be in direct contact with the speakers.

1.5 Registration of faculty

It is mandatory to register all faculty members of your industry sessions for the congress. For these registrations the free registrations can be used as mentioned above under the relevant industry session. Additional registrations can be purchased via the <u>Registration Portal</u>.

Please note that ECNP faculty members cannot be registered through a group. They are registered through ECNP. However, their travel and accommodation expenses and possible other charges are at the costs of the company organising the industry session.

Although every effort will be made to inform you in the event of a double registration, when either an individual or another group registers the same participant, ECNP cannot be held responsible should such an event occur.

The deadline to register the faculty members of your industry session is 14 August 2026.

It is the responsibility of the companies to inform the provisional faculty of these rules.

1.6. Accreditation

For Industry Satellite Symposia and Industry Mini Sessions it is possible to obtain European CME accreditation (optional).

After written approval of the programme has been received from the Scientific Programme Committee (SPC), organisers of Industry Satellite Symposia or Industry Mini Sessions may obtain European accreditation (CME); however, it is not mandatory. The decision as to whether an Industry Satellite Symposium or an Industry Mini Session can be organised during the ECNP Congress remains with ECNP.

If an industry obtains European CME accreditation, this can be mentioned in the online programme of the Industry Satellite Symposium or Industry Mini Session on the <u>ECNP Congress website</u> and App.

Industry Interactive Discussions, Industry Product Theatre sessions and Industry Case Studies will not be granted for CME accreditation.

1.7 Disclosure

ECNP requires speakers, chairs and poster presenters in the scientific programme of ECNP and in the industry sessions to disclose potential conflicts of interest. This will allow the audience to take potential conflicts of interest into account when assessing the objectivity of the presentation. Speakers are requested to disclose potential conflicts of interest regarding their current presentation in the first slide of their presentation. Chairs are also requested to disclose potential conflict of interest regarding the topics of the presentations during their session in the first slide of their session.

1.8 Enduring material

Companies applying for an industry session – where the session is livestreamed and is recorded by ECNP – are allowed to use the recorded content as enduring material for posting on their own website. ECNP will own the copyright of the recording. Content of the programme belongs to the company. The recorded content is provided to the organising company within about a week after the ECNP congress took place.

ECNP permits the re-use of the recorded content of your industry session at the 39th ECNP Congress in order to create enduring material provided that:

- The ECNP copyright remains visible;
- The ECNP logo as fixed in the recording remains;
- The financial disclaimer sentence 'Financially supported by <name company> during the 39th ECNP Congress' remains;
- A reference is made that the content 'Does not imply endorsement by ECNP of the views expressed or the products and/or services that the company offers';
- For promotion only the images as given in the <u>promotional kit</u> are used. Any other image/logo or images from ECNP's App cannot be used.

1.9 Digital and printed materials

Material of the Industry Sessions must have the name of the company involved on the poster at the venue and on the first page of digital material, using the following wording: 'Financially supported by <name company> during the 39th ECNP Congress'. The financial disclaimer sentence will show in the session outline of the congress programme.

Digital material announcing industry sessions will only be distributed by e-mailing to the pre-registered participants approximately 1 or 2 weeks prior to the congress, inviting participants to visit the ECNP Congress website with digital versions of all the invitations for industry sessions produced by the companies.

Promotional materials used in relation to industry sessions should be uploaded via the 'Industry sessions upload portal' via my ECNP for approval. Further details will be given in the ECNP Industry Manual, to be published before 31 May 2026.

2. Exhibition

The ECNP Congress is accompanied by an exhibition, to allow participants to gain access to clinically relevant information and advice. ECNP sees as an important contributor to the congress's knowledge transfer function.

ECNP would like to invite companies and organisations involved in the clinical and pre-clinical research, diagnosis and treatment of disorders of the brain or companies producing products for research or ehealth tools to present their services, products and/or literature at the exhibition, which will be held simultaneously with the congress from Saturday 10 October to Tuesday 13 October 2026.

Exhibitors can apply for space at the exhibition, which will be held in Hall B0 on Level 0 of the ICM München.

For in-person participants tea, coffee and lunch are provided free of charge in the exhibition area during breaks as mentioned in the programme, ensuring maximum contact between exhibitors and participants. Congress catering areas will also be found in the poster area.

For the 39th ECNP Congress there is an official caterer appointed and it is forbidden by the congress venue to bring food and beverages from outside. Limited catering is allowed but is restricted to grab and go and non-alcoholic beverages. It is not allowed to bring food or drinks into the session rooms. Exhibitors are responsible for ensuring that the ordered supplies follow the congress guidelines and the ICM Technical Regulations for Accompanying Exhibitions. Further details will be given in the ECNP Industry Manual, to be published before 31 May 2026.

ECNP reserves the right to determine the eligibility of all exhibition-stand space applications, expecting that all exhibitions will conform to the educational, informational and scientific goals of the 39th ECNP Congress. The allocation of stand space does not mean that the information provided at the exhibition stand is endorsed by ECNP.

Exhibition services at the 39th ECNP Congress are provided by ECNP, ICM München and other designated official service suppliers. The complete list of official suppliers together with their contact details will be available in the ECNP Industry Manual, to be published before 31 May 2026.

All suppliers act on their own behalf in all arrangements with exhibitors and are not agents or employees of ECNP. All services or materials supplied by these companies will be subject to a contract between the suppliers and exhibitors and will be invoiced directly by the suppliers to the exhibitors. Please note that the suppliers may apply their own regulations and instructions to the contracts they use. Therefore, ECNP does not accept any liability or responsibility for any act performed or committed by such suppliers.

2.3 How to apply

To be considered in the initial assignment of a stand space, potential exhibitors must submit their application via the <u>exhibition application form</u>, by 20 January 2026 at the latest.

During the application process, the following information needs to be provided:

- Preferences of space locations (see <u>provisional exhibition floor plan</u> for reference)
- Contact and invoicing details
- Type and size of exhibition space
- Company logo (maximum size of 500KB, send via e-mail)
- Introduction text about the company (maximum of 100 words texts are subject to minor editorial adjustment for conformity to the ECNP house style.)

The company name, company logo and the introduction text are requested for publication on the <u>ECNP</u> <u>Congress website</u> and App.

ECNP will make initial stand space assignments for the exhibition in the congress venue for applications received before 20 January 2026. The exhibition floor plan will be designed in accordance with the actual stand sizes requested and with the ICM Technical Regulations for Accompanying Exhibitions (taking into account escape routes and emergency exits) and with the intention of maximising each individual stand's visibility to the participants of the 39th ECNP Congress.

The stand assignment to applicants that have met the initial deadline will be sent before 17 March 2026. Please note that ECNP's decision in this regard is final. Companies are not allowed to sublet their

assigned stand space. After the initial stand space assignment has been finalised, the remaining space (if available) can be allocated to later applications.

No applications can be accepted after 1 July 2026.

After ECNP has received the application form, the company applying for any exhibition space will be issued an invoice for 100% which must be paid according to the payment terms specified.

2.4 Details of exhibition space

2.4.1 Stand activities

It is expected that companies organise exhibits that are educationally, scientifically and/or medically oriented. Exhibitors are permitted to demonstrate the company's services and equipment and to make informational presentations regarding product lines or services within the stand.

Companies are not permitted to organise meet-the-expert sessions at their stands for a larger audience or use the phrase 'meet-the-expert'. A small desk on the stand is, however allowed for book-signings, or for an expert to meet 2-3 congress participants at the same time but not to publish a programmed schedule.

Companies wishing to organise a session-room-style activity can apply to organise an Industry Session (see chapter <u>1. Industry Sessions</u>).

Only activities which, in the opinion of ECNP, are in line with the exhibition's educational, informational, scientific and medical goals will be permitted. ECNP reserves the right to end activities or to close a stand.

2.4.2 Stand information

A choice of shell scheme or free-build (space only) stands are offered to exhibitors.

Allocated space for free-build stands is hired based on stand space only. Stand space is defined as square metres (m^2) up to the maximum height as it will be indicated under height restriction in the ECNP Industry Manual, to be published before 31 May 2026.

Stand constructions at the congress venue should adhere to the following criteria:

- Stands must not be obstructive in any way (openness of individual stands and the exhibition in general is aimed for at all times).
- Stands should be transparent and openly constructed.
 - o a maximum of 2 meters of the length of the stand is allowed to be a closed wall or similar, when the length of the side is equal or less than 6 meters.
 - o a maximum of 1/3 of the length of the stand is allowed to be a closed wall or similar when the length of the side is above 6 meters.
- Only single-story stands are allowed.
- Shell scheme stands are available as packages of 6, 9 or 12 square meters and the type of stand (row or corner stand) will depend on the final location of the stand which will be indicated in the final allocation letter.

The final approval of the stand design rests with ECNP.

2.4.3 Free-build stands

For exhibitors who choose to build their own stand (free-build stands) at the congress venue, stand construction and stand services are at the exhibitor's expense.

Stands may not be constructed without ECNP's written approval. Details about the required documents and drawings needed for approval will be available in the ECNP Industry Manual, to be published before 31 May 2026.

2.4.4 Shell scheme stands

Companies that order a shell scheme package at the congress venue can choose 6, 9 or 12 square meters.

Commercial shell scheme packages

These stands, to meet local compliance rules of Health Care Professionals, will be placed within the exhibition area.

All row stands of 6 square meters (3m back wall x 2m side panels) will have a first side panel of 2.50 meters high, the next side panel is 1 meter high. The back panels are 2.50 meters high.

The package of 9 square meters (3m back wall x 3m side panels) have the first two side panels of 2.50 meters high, the third side panel is 1 meter high.

The package of 12 square metres (4m back wall x 3m side panels) will have four back walls of 2.50 meters. The side panels are the same as a 9-square-metre stands.

For corner stands the last 1-meter-high panels on one side will be left out.

Publishers/booksellers/associations

These stands do not need to meet local compliance rules of Health Care Professionals. Therefore these will not necessarily be placed within the exhibition area.

All row stands of 6 square meters (3m back wall x 2m side panels) will have a first side panel of 2.50 meters high, the next side panel is 1 meter high. The back panels are 2.50 meters high.

The package of 9 square meters (3m back wall x 3m side panels) have the first side panels of 2.50 meters high, the second and third side panel is 1 meter high.

The package of 12 square metres (4m back wall x 3m side panels) will have four back walls of 2.50 meters. The side panels are the same as a 9-square-metre stands.

For corner stands the last 1-meter-high panels on one side will be left out.

Shell scheme packages include the panels as described above, electricity usage, carpeting and fascia panelling with standard lettering. Furniture and other services should be ordered directly by the exhibitor using the order information provided in the ECNP Industry Manual, to be published before 31 May 2026.

2.4.5 Free badges included

Exhibitors are entitled to a certain number of in-person congress registrations, depending on the size of their stand. Congress participants badges give access to all congress activates listed on the <u>scientific programme schedule of the 39th ECNP Congress</u> and it also gives access to the App. Companies wishing to buy additional registrations can use the <u>registration form</u> (registration opens in January 2026).
