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




## European Quality In Preclinical Data

Improving quality and rigour in preclinical studies for the future of drug development

THE CHALLENGE Poor-quality data is a serious challenge in drug development, negatively impacting the transition from preclinical to clinical testing, resulting in higher failure rates and longer drug development times. There is an urgent need for simple, sustainable solutions to improve data quality.



THE GOAL To deliver simple and sustainable solutions to facilitate data quality without impacting innovation.

THE PLAN By analysing the variables in study design and data analysis that influence outcomes across academia and industry, the project will define the components of an EQIPD quality management system and work to achieve a consensus among different stakeholders on quality management recommendations for research.
