My name is Olgha Kukhianidze, I am psychiatrist in Center for Mental Health and Prevention of Addiction from Tbilisi, Gerogia. I am clinician and work in acute psychotic department, mainly with in patients, as well I have some private practice with out patients. My sphere of interest include the treatment resistant patients with Major Depressive Disorder and also problems in diagnosis and treatment patients with dual diagnosis (depressive or psychotic disorders and drug abuse).
