## Report for ECNP supported talk at the 4th Young psychiatrists' network meeting

"Randomness and causality in medical practice and research"

ECNP supported Lecture on 4<sup>th</sup> of April 11.15-12.15 by **Professor Michal Davidson** 

The 4th Young psychiatrists' network meeting took place in Wroclaw, Poland and was devoted to the topic: "A coin with many sides: different perspectives on mental illness". It brought representatives of different point of view in current Mental Health Care together to inspire dialogues between them and young psychiatrists.

During the last day of the meeting there was an additional section on Young Psychiatrists' Associations where Olga Paravaya spread information and materials on J-MAP of ECNP.
