

Angela Vincent (Hon PhD Bergen) FRCPath FRCP FMedSci FRS is Professor of Neuroimmunology in the University of Oxford. She has spent over 35 years working on autoantibodies to specific receptors, ion channels and related proteins in neurological diseases, and investigating their mechanisms in these conditions using in vitro and in vivo techniques. She holds an Honorary Consultant position in Immunology and runs the Clinical Neuroimmunology service in Oxford which is an international referral centre for the measurement of antibodies in neurological diseases. She and her colleagues collaborate with neurologists worldwide. She was an Associate Editor of Brain (2004-2013) and was formerly Head of Department of Clinical Neurology (2005-2008), served on the MRC Neurosciences and Mental Health Board (2004-2008), and was President of the International Society of Neuroimmunology (2001-2004).
